Meeting Minutes

July 2, 2019

Opening

The regular meeting of the WEST BARNSTABLE CIVIC ASSOCIATION was called to order at 7:05pm on July 2, 2019 at Burgess House by Nancy Meagher, President.

Approval of Minutes

Approval of minutes was deferred to next month due to lack of quorum.

Councilor's Report

- Town's operating budget of \$210 million has been approved.
- 59 projects totaling \$34 million has been approved
- CPC has approved \$177,000 for completion of renovation of Paine Black House. \$50,000 supplemental will be granted from Town of Barnstable funds. Agenda item will be submitted at Town Council Meeting August 15, 2019 at 7:00 PM.
- Additional grants in Barnstable Harbor. Home Rule petitions and incremental increases will occur.
- Clean up still going on at Shooting Range
- Voting for Precinct 11 will be in the Community Building now that renovations are complete.

Officer Reports

- Bob Stolte sent word that he needs new checks, \$500 was received from the Town of Barnstable for the Parade, all scholarship checks have been cashed and money has been received for the festival. Made a special thanks for Paine Black House interest.
- Scholarship Committee – Nancy Meagher reported that Committee was looking to do something different for fund raising this next year.

Old Business

- Nancy thanked Judy Desrocher for sharing background information and leading the tour of the Paine Black House
- Fourth of July Celebration update – With Gary Cremean's help, we were able to rent a tent, Bouncy House and Dunk tank for \$1000. Ed Jay and Bob Stolte reported that \$5790 was received through Go Fund Me donations by 43 people in 1 month. They are expecting a lot of fun in the Hollow. Parade starts at 9 AM. Ed Jay stated that he would take care of any money left over from this year's parade and that it would be rolled over to next year's festivities.
- Flag Day went well. 30 attended. Photos were in the Barnstable Patriot. We will try to promote it more next year.

New Business

- WB Festival – Nancy will e-mail for volunteers to work in shifts selling stickers, Year in Review and raffle tickets.
- Cornerstone article submission deadline is July 22
- Phil Wallace said that two individuals on Wheeler Avenue have voiced concerns with airplanes pulling banners from airfield and noise of DC3. He is to meet with them to discuss it on July 3rd.
- Gary Cremeans is unable to hold banner this year in parade. Nancy and Andy will carry the WBCA Banner. Nancy will return the banner to the cage after the parade.
