# Approval of Minutes

A vote to approve the April 4, 2023, minutes will be taken at the June 6th Meeting as a quorum was not present.

#### Report from Precinct 11 Councilor Kris Clark

### Town and local updates:

I've been working with Judge Joe Reardon, Trustee of the Lombard Trust, to work with the town manager, assistant town manager and the Legal Department to reconcile the ownership of the West Barnstable Railroad Station. The Judge contends that the Town owns the Train Station building and that the Trust merely owns the land. The Town's Legal Dept. contends that the Trust owns the Train Station. Over this past weekend, the Judge sent to the Town documents that show that the Town owns the Railroad Station and Attorney McLaughlin finally agreed. In the meantime, the Town Architect will proceed with filing the application for funds from the Massachusetts Historical Commission. We believe that this will finally be resolved.

The Town Manager has now received three letters of support for the purchase of the 18 acres of open space that is currently for sale adjacent to the Bridge Creek Conservation Area. The request for an appraisal was before the Community Preservation Committee. The appraisal has been completed, but a CPC member asked that this property also be evaluated for housing and that has not yet been done. It is zoned as Chapter 61B property, giving the Town the first right of refusal. I've been meeting with various councilors to lobby for their support.

The Town Council has voted on items that have been suggested by the Town Manager and staff for Capital Improvements to our Town. The agenda for this Thursday continues this process.

Rusty Gage and Samantha Gray are heading up the volunteer effort to place flags on Veteran's gravestones in West Barnstable. Sunday, May 28th is the targeted date for this...time to be determined.

Lombard Field has had the gates locked because some folks are using it as a dog park. Dogs were diggings holes throughout the field and urinating on the grass (kills the grass). Bags of dog poop were found inside the dugout, under the bench where players sit during the game. The gates are now open, but please pass the word that there is now a dog park in Barnstable. Dogs should not be on ball fields where users pay to use the fields.

The WB Fire District held its meeting on April 26. Ed Smith was reelected to continue as Prudential Committee member and Brian Paradise was elected as the new Water Commissioner. The next Water Commissioner's meeting will be on Monday, June 5<sup>th</sup> at 6:30pm at the WB Community Building.

Tomorrow, May 3, at 7pm, there is a public hearing from the Commonwealth of MA for the proposed transfer of land to Cape Cod Community College. It will be held at CCCC's Lorusso Technology Building, Room 114.

Herring were relayed to Mill Pond today by the MA Division of Marine Fisheries and the Marine and Environmental Affairs Division. Given that Mill Pond does not have public access, the relay was conducted on private property with the support and permission of the property owner. It is the hope that the herring will imprint on this pond and reestablish a population there. So far, the monitoring results are not encouraging from the relay efforts done in the past.

Today, I heard that due to this week's weather, MA DOT is cancelling operations for the remainder of the week. Paving and bridge joint work are rescheduled for Monday 5-8-23 and Tuesday 5-9-23, weather permitting. The detour will be in place for both of these night shifts.




